### **Competitor Guidelines**

#### **ENTRIES**

Each competitor can only enter once in each category.

Staff members may enter the separate categories designated for Staff.

All entries must be personally submitted for competition by their creator on the day of the competition.

- Entries must be submitted between 5pm and 7pm on Saturday November 5, 2011.
- Judging will conclude at 8:30pm
- Staff entries will be voted on by competitors
- Iron Ogre is a separate competition from the Privateer Press Painting Challenge. Models may be entered into both competitions if the category allows.

Each competitor is fully responsible for the transport of their entries to and from the competition. Naturally, once an entry is submitted for competition, MECHANICON will attempt to prevent any harm to the entry. MECHANICON does not, however, accept any responsibility for loss or damage to entries. Submissions are entered into the competition at the competitor's own risk.

Entry in the competition gives MECHANICON the right to photograph and publish details of the models as we see fit.

Competitors are encouraged to contact us in advance with information about what categories they plan to enter so that we can plan proper display space.

## **CATEGORIES**

### **Category 1 - Warhammer 40,000 Single Miniature**

Any single 40K non-vehicle 28mm scale model mounted on an appropriately sized gaming base. Forge World models may be entered in this category. Conversions or scratch builds may be entered in this category. This category includes, but is not limited to 25mm, 40mm, 60mm, flying and bike bases. Note that bike mounted models must be entered in this category, not in category 3.

### **Category 2 - Warhammer 40,000 Squad**

This category is for legal 40K squads of 3 or more non-vehicle 28mm scale models on appropriately sized gaming bases. Forge World models may be entered in this category. Conversions or scratch builds may be entered in this category. Note that squads of bike mounted models may be entered in this category.

### **Category 3 - Warhammer 40,000 Vehicle**

This category is open to a single 40K vehicle, dreadnought, or walker 28 mm scale model. This category includes titans, flyers and super-heavies. Forge World models may be entered in this category. Conversions or scratch builds may be entered in this category.

### **Category 4 - Single Miniature Open**

This category is open to any single non-vehicle 25-32 mm scale model mounted on an appropriately sized gaming base no larger than 40mm. The genre may be science fiction, fantasy, or historical. Any manufacturer's model may be entered in this category. Conversions or scratch builds may be entered in this category.

### **Category 5 - Single Large Miniature Open**

This category is open to any single model, vehicle or non-vehicle, in any scale. Maximum size of entries in this category must not exceed 18" x 18" x 18". The genre may be science fiction, fantasy, or historical. Any manufacturer's model may be entered in this category. Conversions or scratch builds may be entered in this category.

### **Category 6 – Wide Open Competition**

This category is open to single models, dioramas, or whatever you wish. Maximum size of entries in this category must not exceed 18" x 18" x 18". The genre may be science fiction, fantasy, or historical. Any manufacturer's model may be entered in this category. Conversions or scratch builds may be entered in this category.
